

Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The Medina County Hospital District will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 61% percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax rate calculated under Tax Code Chapter 26). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on September 9, 2019 @ 6 PM at 3100 Ave E, Hondo, TX 78861.

The second public hearing will be held on September 16, 2019 @ 6 PM at 3100 Ave E, Hondo, TX 78861.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in Medina County last year was \$ 144,340

Based on last year's tax rate of \$ 0.0645 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$ 93.10 (tax on average taxable value of a residence homestead in the taxing unit for the preceding tax year, disregarding residence homestead exemptions available only to disabled persons or persons 65 years of age or older)

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in Medina County this year is \$ 152,103
average taxable value of a residence homestead in the taxing unit for the current tax year, disregarding residence homestead exemptions available only to disabled persons or persons 65 years of age or older). If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$ 0.0622 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 94.61 (tax on average taxable value of a residence homestead in the taxing unit for the current tax year, disregarding residence homestead exemptions available only to disabled persons or persons 65 years of age or older)

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$ 0.1000 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 152.10 (tax on the average taxable value of a residence homestead in the taxing unit for the current tax year, disregarding residence homestead exemptions available only to disabled persons or persons 65 years of age or older)
